WHEREAS, the mission statement of the department is a declaration of department priorities and sets the tone for the work of the department, department staff, and the State; and

WHEREAS, the department's current mission statement is "to support the development of a Hawaii economy that embraces innovation; an economy that is globally competitive, dynamic, and productive; and provides opportunities for all Hawaii's citizens"; and

WHEREAS, it is important that the department expressly include in its mission statement the development of a business friendly culture in the State; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism is urged to amend its mission statement to expressly include the development of a business friendly culture in the State; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department is urged to consider adopting a mission statement that reads: "The Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism's mission is to support the development of a Hawaii economy that is business friendly, embraces innovation; an economy that is globally competitive, dynamic, and productive; and provides opportunities for all Hawaii's citizens."; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and the Director of Business, Economic Development and Tourism.
