## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

---

SUPPORTING A REQUEST BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO USE  
FEDERAL PROPERTY BELOW THE H-1 VIADUCT IN PEARL CITY AS A  
SITE ON WHICH TO CONSTRUCT LOW-COST HOUSING.

1 WHEREAS, the island of Oahu is experiencing a devastating  
2 homelessness crisis and there is a persistent shortage of  
3 housing that is affordable to low-income persons; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, locating and acquiring physical space in which to  
6 establish housing for low-income persons is often challenging;  
7 and  
8

9 WHEREAS, unused or underutilized space beneath freeway  
10 viaducts may provide opportunities to construct low-cost  
11 housing; and  
12

13 WHEREAS, approximately six acres of land beneath the H-1  
14 viaduct, ewa of Hugh Street in Pearl City, has been identified  
15 as a location that could accommodate approximately twenty low-  
16 cost modular homes; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, the subject property, identified as F.A.P. No. I-  
19 H1-1(13), is controlled by the federal government, and the state  
20 Department of Transportation is requesting federal permission to  
21 erect the low-income housing there; and  
22

23 WHEREAS, the Legislature supports efforts to provide low-  
24 cost housing to needy persons who might otherwise be homeless;  
25 now, therefore,

27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
28 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
29 of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the Legislature is in full  
30 support of the Department of Transportation's request for

1 federal permission to use property beneath the H-1 viaduct, ewa  
2 of Hugh Street in Pearl City, to erect low-cost housing for  
3 needy persons; and

7 Department of Transportation, the Department of Transportation,
