

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER CONVENE AN INSURANCE MODERNIZATION WORKING GROUP TO UPDATE AND MODERNIZE THE STATE'S PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE AND LIFE INSURANCE LAWS.

WHEREAS, the State's Insurance Code, codified in Chapter 1 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, was originally drafted in 1987 and 2 has not been substantively updated to account for technological 3 innovations, such as the Internet and smart phones; and 4 5 WHEREAS, technology and consumer expectations are rapidly 6 transforming the regulated insurance industry; and 7 8 WHEREAS, substantial investments in innovative insurance 9 products, services, and technologies hold great promise for 10 improving the mitigation of risks, improving efficiencies, 11 reducing costs of insurance transactions, expediting claims 12 payments, and improving overall customer understanding of, and 13 satisfaction with, this essential form of financial protection; 14 and 15 16 WHEREAS, some innovations will disrupt current insurance 17 business models and introduce new and more efficient ways of 18 doing business; and 19 20 WHEREAS, by actively engaging with and encouraging the 21 piloting and testing of new and innovative ways of delivering 22 insurance to businesses and consumers, the State will be able to 23 expand insurance markets, particularly by making insurance 24 transactions more accessible for first-time insurance buyers; 25 and 26 27 WHEREAS, strict application of uniformly applicable 28 requirements can lead to unintended results when new and 29

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innovative technologies, products, and services are first tested 1 in a closely-regulated marketplace, such as insurance; now, 2 therefore, 3 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 5 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 6 of 2018, the Senate concurring, that the Insurance Commissioner 7 is requested to convene an insurance modernization working group 8 to explore and propose legislation to update and modernize 9 Hawaii's property and casualty insurance and life insurance 10 11 laws; and 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Insurance Commissioner is 13 requested to invite the following to serve as members of the 14 insurance modernization working group: 15 16 One representative from each of the five largest (1)17 property and casualty insurers operating in the State; 18 19 One representative from each of the three largest life 20 (2) insurers operating in the State; 21 22 One representative from the Hawaii Independent (3) 23 Insurance Agents Association; 24 25 One representative from the National Association of (4) 26 Insurance and Financial Advisors; and 27 28 One representative from the Hawaii Association for (5) 29 Justice; and 30 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the insurance modernization 32 working group is requested to submit a written report of its 33 findings, recommendations, and proposed legislation to the 34 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 35 the Regular Session of 2019; and 36 37

Commissioner, who in turn is requested to provide copies of this
Concurrent Resolution to representatives invited to join the
insurance modernization working group.
