HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ALLOW THE COUNTIES TO USE VACANT STATE LANDS AS STORAGE FOR ABANDONED VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, abandoned vehicles in the State of Hawaii are a 1 2 safety issue, an environmental issue, and a parking issue; and 3 4 WHEREAS, in 2016, the City and County of Honolulu towed about 1,600 abandoned vehicles and tow companies complained that 5 their lots are overcrowded with abandoned and derelict vehicles 6 and they do not have the space to store any more vehicles; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, abandoned vehicles often become objects of graffiti and vandalism in residential areas, which makes them 10 11 eyesores and a danger to nearby residents; and 12 WHEREAS, some of the vehicles are abandoned on public 13 14 property and can remain there for months at a time; and 15 WHEREAS, abandoned vehicles often become occupied by 16 homeless individuals; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, according to the Department of Customer Services, the City and County of Honolulu has requested an additional two 20 to four acres of land for one to two years to store abandoned 21 22 vehicles; and 23 24 WHEREAS, towing companies have experienced increased operating costs in the past few years due to an increase in 25 industrial real-estate values, which has resulted in a loss of 26 storage lots for towed vehicles, and it is difficult to obtain 27 additional storage lots from property owners because they are 28

hesitant to lease their land to a towing company; and

WHEREAS, when towing companies' lots are full, they need to 1 2 travel to other lots that are further away to store the abandoned vehicles, which results in higher operating costs for 3 4 the towing companies; and 5 6 WHEREAS, towing companies may not be interested in county 7 contracts because available storage lots are in areas that would 8 increase their travel expenses; and 9 10 WHEREAS, between 2011 and 2016, about 1,440 abandoned vehicles on towing storage lots in Oahu were traced to military 11 12 personnel who abandoned their vehicles when they left the island, creating further storage problems for towing companies; 13 14 and 15 WHEREAS, military vehicles that are ferried into the State 16 17 cost the counties even more than the typical abandoned vehicle, and these military vehicles make up a significant portion of 18 abandoned vehicles in the State; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources has control over State lands that may be currently vacant and not 22 23 being used for any purpose; and 24 25 WHEREAS, allowing the counties to use the Department's vacant land to store abandoned vehicles would eliminate the 26 costs that towing companies would otherwise incur from storing 27 abandoned vehicles on their premises; now, therefore, 28 29 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 31 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is 32 urged to allow the counties to use the Department's vacant state 33 34 lands as storage for abandoned vehicles; and 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 37 Natural Resources is urged to give the counties the discretion to select from any available state land under the jurisdiction 38 39 of the Department of Land and Natural Resources; and
