A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY MEETINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 92-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 3 "(e) Two or more members of a board, but less than the
- 4 number of members which would constitute a quorum for the board,
- 5 may attend an informational meeting or presentation on matters
- 6 relating to official board business, including a meeting of
- 7 another entity, legislative hearing, convention, seminar, or
- 8 community meeting $[\tau]$ open to the public; provided that the
- 9 meeting or presentation is not specifically and exclusively
- 10 organized for or directed toward members of the board. The
- 11 board members in attendance may participate in discussions,
- 12 including discussions among themselves; provided that the
- 13 discussions occur during and as part of the informational
- 14 meeting or presentation; and provided further that no commitment
- 15 relating to a vote on the matter is made or sought.
- 16 At the next duly noticed meeting of the board, the board
- 17 members shall report their attendance and the matters presented



- 1 and discussed that related to official board business at the
- 2 informational meeting or presentation.
- 3 Notwithstanding section 92-3.1, for purposes of this
- 4 subsection, the limitation on the number of members that may
- 5 attend an informational meeting or presentation shall not apply
- 6 to members of a county council."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Open Meetings; Sunshine Law; Permitted Interactions; County Councils

Description:

Exempts members of a county council from the limitation on the number of members that may attend an informational meeting or presentation on matters relating to official board business, including a meeting of another entity, legislative hearing, convention, seminar, or community meeting. Clarifies that such meetings shall be open to the public for purposes of permitted interactions.
