A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-206, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 4 limiter; violation. (a) A [motor used to power a] moped shall
- 5 not be modified in any manner by the owner of the moped or by a
- 6 moped dealer or repair shop, including modifying a motor used to
- 7 power a moped or removing a speed limiter to increase the top
- 8 speed and horsepower, except as authorized by the motor
- 9 manufacturer and any such modification shall not increase the
- 10 power capacity of the motor above two horsepower (one thousand
- 11 four hundred ninety-two watts).
- (b) For purposes of this section, "speed limiter" means a
- device used to limit the top speed of a vehicle.
- 14 [\(\frac{(b)}{b}\)] (c) Any [\(\frac{person}{person}\)] owner who violates this section
- 15 shall be fined not more than \$500. Violation of this section by
- 16 a moped dealer or repair shop shall constitute a petty
- 17 misdemeanor punishable by a fine under section 706-640(e)."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Mopeds; Modification; Penalty

Description:

Prohibits the owner of a moped or a moped dealer or repair shop from modifying a moped, including removing a speed limiter, to increase the top speed and horsepower. Makes current fine applicable to moped owners. Increases penalty to a petty misdemeanor fine for a moped dealer or repair shop.
