A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SAFETY HELMETS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1	. Section 286-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended to read as follows:		
3	"(a) No	person shall:	
4	(1) Oper	ate a motorcycle or motor scooter, on any highway	
5	in t	he State unless the person and any passenger the	
6	pers	on carries on the motorcycle or motor scooter	
7	wear	s:	
8	(A)	A safety helmet securely fastened with a chin	
9		strap;	
10	[-(A)-]	(B) Safety glasses, goggles, or a face shield,	
11		in the case of a motorcycle or motor scooter that	
12		is not equipped with windscreens or windshields;	
13		and	
14	[(B)]	(C) Any other protective devices, [other than a	
15		safety helmet, required by rules adopted by the	
16		director.

19		the person's own use the protective devices
20		required by this part.

6		safety glasses, goggles, face shield, windscreen,	
7		windshield, or other protective devices represented to

10		by rules adopted by the director.	
11	[-(b)	No person less than eighteen years of age shall	
12	operate o	r ride as a passenger on a motorcycle or motor scooter	
13	on any hi	ghway in the State unless the person wears a safety	
14	helmet securely fastened with a chin strap.		
15	(c)]	(b) A safety helmet shall not be required for any	
16	person who operates or rides as a passenger on a motorcycle or		
17	motor [scooter; provided that] scooter if the motorcycle or		
18	motor scooter:		
19	(1)	Has three wheels;	
20	(2)	Is powered by an electric motor;	
21	(3)	Has a full body enclosed cab; and	

1	(4) Has a seat belt assembly or a child restraint system
2	for the driver and passenger;
3	and the operator and passenger uses the seat belt or child
4	restraint system pursuant to sections 291-11.5 and 291-11.6."
5	SECTION 2. Section 291C-195, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
7	"(a) No person less than fifteen years of age shall drive
8	a moped on a highway, street, roadway, or any other public
9	property in the State. No person [less than eighteen years of
10	age] shall drive a moped or ride as a passenger on a moped
11	unless the person wears a safety helmet securely fastened with a
12	chin strap. The safety helmet shall meet the specifications and
13	requirements established by rules adopted by the director."
14	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
