A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL IDENTIFICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-303, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Application for renewal of an identification card
- 4 issued after November 1, 1998, for an individual eighty years of
- 5 age or older may be done by mailing in a completed application
- 6 and fee, if there is no change in name and citizenship status.
- 7 The director shall adopt rules to allow for renewal by mail for
- 8 individuals with physical or intellectual disabilities for whom
- 9 application in person presents a serious burden. For an
- 10 individual who has a letter from a licensed primary care
- 11 provider certifying that a severe disability causes the
- 12 individual to be homebound, the director shall adopt rules
- 13 allowing for application for renewal of an identification card
- 14 under this section by means other than in person appearance."
- 15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Requires the Director of Transportation to adopt rules to allow an individual who has a letter from a licensed primary care provider certifying that a severe disability causes the individual to be homebound to renew a State identification card by means other than an in person appearance.
