RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 3 to read as follows: . HOUSING SUPPORT PROGRAM 4 "PART 5 §356D-A Definitions. As used in this part: 6 "Participating landlord" means a property owner or property 7 manager who has entered an agreement with the authority to participate in the housing support program and offer rental 8 9 housing units to eligible individuals or families. 10 "Participating unit" means a rental housing unit that has 11 been designated by a participating landlord for occupancy by an 12 eligible individual or family. 13 Housing support program; established. (a) §356D-B There 14 is established within the authority a housing support program 15 that shall provide housing support payments to participating

16 landlords on behalf of persons or families who meet the

17 eligibility requirements provided in section 356D-C.



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1	(b)	The authority shall establish rules pursuant to
2	chapter 9	1 for the purpose of implementing this part.
3	§356	D-C Eligibility for housing support payment. (a) A
4	person or	family is eligible for housing support payments if
5	that person or family:	
6	(1)	Meets the definition of "qualified tenant" under
7		section 356D-153 and does not own personal property
8		and assets in excess of \$10,000; or
9	(2)	Is a participant in a housing first program or service
10		established pursuant to section 346-378.
11	(b)	The authority shall conduct annual eligibility
12	evaluations of all persons or families who are receiving housing	
13	support payments.	
14	(c)	Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, income from
15	other state or federal need-based benefit programs shall not be	
16	included in any calculation to determine eligibility for housing	
17	support payments.	
18	(d)	The authority shall evaluate the eligibility of a
19	person or	family before making housing benefit payments on
20	behalf of	that person or family. The eligibility of a person or



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family who is receiving housing support payment benefits shall 1 2 be reevaluated at least once every twelve months. §356D-D Housing support payments; monthly rates. (a) The 3 authority shall negotiate monthly support payment rates with 4 participating landlords; provided that rates shall not exceed 5 the total of: 6 Sixty per cent of the federal poverty level, divided 7 (1)by twelve and rounding down the quotient, for a family 8 9 with a number of members equal to the intended 10 occupancy of the participating unit; and (2) The maximum allotment authorized by the federal food 11 stamp program for a single individual that is in 12 13 effect on the first day of July each year. The authority shall make housing support payments to 14 (b) 15 participating landlords on behalf of qualified persons and 16 families who are occupying participating units. The method and 17 frequency of housing support payments shall be specified in the negotiations between the authority and each participating 18 19 landlord pursuant to this section.

20 §356D-E Housing support program special fund. There is
21 established in the state treasury the housing support program



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1 special fund to be administered by the authority and into which
2 shall be deposited appropriations made by the legislature to the
3 special fund. Moneys in the special fund shall be used for the
4 purpose of making housing support payments pursuant to this
5 part."

6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to be
9 deposited into the housing support program special fund.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the housing support program special fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the housing support program to make housing support payments on behalf of eligible persons and families.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii public 16 housing authority for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
