A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BIOSECURITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that responding quickly
- 2 to newly detected terrestrial and aquatic biosecurity
- 3 emergencies in the State can often "nip the problem in the bud"
- 4 and prevent biosecurity threats from becoming firmly
- 5 established, thus saving taxpayers money in the long term.
- 6 State agencies currently lack resources and a mechanism to
- 7 quickly respond to new threats and, therefore, may be missing
- 8 opportunities to eliminate those threats. This may allow new
- 9 terrestrial and aquatic biosecurity threats to become
- 10 established in the State and make efforts to mitigate or
- 11 eliminate them more protracted and expensive.
- 12 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to create a
- 13 mechanism for rapid response to terrestrial and aquatic
- 14 biosecurity emergencies at or beyond ports in the State so that
- 15 newly detected threats may be immediately addressed.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part VI to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§150A- Biosecurity emergency response special fund.
5	(a) There is established the biosecurity emergency response
6	special fund, into which shall be deposited appropriations by
7	the legislature for the purpose of supporting multiagency
8	terrestrial and aquatic emergency responses at or beyond ports
9	by emergency task forces to mitigate or eradicate newly detected
10	terrestrial and aquatic biosecurity threats in the State. All
11	interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited into the fund
12	shall become part of the fund. The department shall administer
13	the special fund and may expend moneys in the special fund in
14	accordance with this section.
15	(b) If the department determines that one or more newly
16	detected terrestrial or aquatic biosecurity threats pose a
17	substantial risk to the agriculture, commerce, economy,
18	environment, or public health of the State or otherwise warrant
19	immediate action, the department shall submit a request to the
20	governor to declare that there exists a biosecurity emergency.

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         (c) Upon declaration by the governor pursuant to
    subsection (b) that there exists a biosecurity emergency, the
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    department may take action in response to the emergency and make
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    expenditures from the fund without legislative approval and
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    without regard to chapters 36, 37, 89, and 103D.
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         (d) The department shall make an accounting of moneys
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    expended from the fund and shall include that information in its
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    annual report to the legislature."
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         SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
    revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of $

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    deposit into the biosecurity emergency response special fund.
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         SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the biosecurity
    emergency response special fund the sum of $

    much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to
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    support multiagency terrestrial and aquatic emergency responses
    at or beyond ports by emergency task forces to mitigate or
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    eradicate newly detected terrestrial and aquatic biosecurity
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    threats in the State.
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         The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
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    agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
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- 1 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
