A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF CONFIDENTIAL PERSONAL INFORMATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 708-800, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending the definition of "Confidential personal information" to read as follows:

"Confidential personal information" means information in which ~~[an individual]~~ a person has a significant privacy interest, including but not limited to a person's entire driver's license number[, a] or social security number[, an]; the entire identifying number of a person's depository, investment, or credit account[, a bank account number, a password,]; a person's entire credit card number or medical record number; or a username and password that, when used in conjunction, provide access to a person's credit card account; medical records, or depository, investment, or credit account [or other information that is used for accessing information, or any other name, number, or code that is used, alone or in conjunction with other information, to confirm the identity of a person] ."

1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
