## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATIONS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 279D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
3	and to read as follows:
4	"Metropolitan planning area" means a metropolitan planning
5	area determined under 23 United States Code section 134, as
6	amended."
7	SECTION 2. Section 279D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
9	"(a) Policy board membership shall be established by
10	comprehensive agreement, including any applicable supplemental
11	agreements and bylaws[+]; provided that:
12	(1) At least one member shall be a resident of the
13	applicable metropolitan planning area and a member of
14	the senate appointed by the president of the senate;
15	and
16	(2) At least one member shall be a resident of the
17	applicable metropolitan planning area and a member of

1	the house of representatives appointed by the speaker
2	of the house of representatives."
3	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
5	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
6	provided that a metropolitan planning organization policy board
7	member whose term may be affected by this Act shall continue to
8	serve on the policy board until the member's term expires or the
9	member is replaced by the respective presiding officer of the
10	house of the legislature with appointing authority over the
11	respective policy board seat, whichever occurs first.
