A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOWING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part XII to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"§291C- Towing; inoperable ticket issuing machine; prohibited. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, towing companies shall be prohibited from towing a vehicle that is parked in a parking stall that would otherwise require a person to pay for parking by means of a ticket issuing machine if the ticket issuing machine is inoperable.

(b) For the purposes of this section, "ticket issuing machine" means a machine or device that issues, as a result of money or other permitted form of payment being inserted into the machine or device or otherwise transacted using the machine or device, a ticket showing the period during which it is lawful to remain parked in the area to which the machine or device is referable."

SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.




