A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that consumption of fresh
- 2 fruit and vegetables is an integral part of a healthy diet and
- 3 central to the prevention of obesity and disease. Every
- 4 community should have adequate access to such healthy dietary
- 5 options; however, high cost and poor quality often make this
- 6 difficult.
- 7 The legislature further finds that, to increase access to
- 8 fresh fruits and vegetables for beneficiaries of the federal
- 9 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, some states have
- 10 enacted farmers' market matching incentive programs. Under such
- 11 programs, individuals who purchase produce at local farmers'
- 12 markets using their nutrition assistance benefits receive
- 13 additional benefits on a dollar-for-dollar basis up to a certain
- 14 amount.
- 15 The legislature further finds that farmers' market matching
- 16 incentive programs have not only increased access to healthy
- 17 dietary options, but have also helped invigorate local economies

- 1 and address food insecurity. Previous legislation introduced in
- 2 Hawaii to establish such a program was supported by community
- 3 and scientific groups. Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to
- 4 require the department of agriculture to develop and administer
- 5 a local health food incentive program promoting the purchase of
- 6 fruits and vegetables for beneficiaries of the Supplemental
- 7 Nutrition Assistance Program.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 10 and to read as follows:
- 11 "§141- Local health food incentive program; special
- 12 <u>fund</u>. (a) There is established a local health food incentive
- 13 program for beneficiaries of the Supplemental Nutrition
- 14 Assistance Program. The program shall be developed and
- 15 administered by the department of agriculture.
- 16 (b) Beneficiaries of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
- 17 Program who use food stamps to make purchases at a farmers'
- 18 market and other direct food retailers who participate in the
- 19 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program shall receive a
- 20 dollar-for-dollar match up to \$20 per month to be used
- 21 exclusively for purchases of fresh fruits and vegetables at a

- 1 farmers' market or other direct food retailer. "Farmers'
- 2 market" shall have the same meaning as in section
- 3 205-2(d)(15)(D).
- 4 (c) There is established within the department of
- 5 agriculture a local health food incentive program special fund,
- 6 into which shall be deposited any legislative appropriations and
- 7 any public or private grants, awards, or gifts for the purpose
- 8 of the local health food incentive program. Moneys in the
- 9 special fund may be expended by the department to administer the
- 10 program and to provide matching funds to beneficiaries.
- 11 (d) The department of agriculture may cooperate with
- 12 private organizations to develop rules for the local health food
- 13 incentive program."
- 14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to be
- 17 deposited into the local health food incentive program special
- 18 fund.
- 19 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the local health
- 20 food incentive program special fund the sum of \$300,000 or so
- 21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for

- 1 administration of the local health food incentive program and to
- 2 provide matching funds to beneficiaries of the Supplemental
- 3 Nutrition Assistance Program.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
