### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CLIMATE CHANGE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that climate change is a
- 2 major threat to Hawaii. Act 32, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017,
- 3 states, "The legislature finds that not only is climate change
- 4 real, but it is the overriding challenge of the 21st century .
- 5 . . Climate change poses immediate and long-term threats to the
- 6 State's economy, sustainability, security, and way of life. .
- 7 . . "
- 8 Article XI, section 1, of the Hawaii State Constitution
- 9 requires the State and its political divisions to "conserve and
- 10 protect Hawaii's natural beauty and all natural resources . .
- 11 . " for future generations. Further, the Paris Agreement states
- 12 that "all Parties are to undertake and communicate ambitious
- 13 efforts" to strengthen their response to the threat of climate
- 14 change.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to require state agencies to
- 16 conduct climate vulnerability assessments for projects involving
- 17 building, transportation, or land use change.

1	SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
2	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
3	as follows:

5	CLIMATE VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT
6	§ -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless the
7	context requires otherwise:
8	"Climate vulnerability assessment" means a project analysis
9	that includes a life cycle analysis of the project's gross and
10	net carbon emissions, the vulnerability of the project to
11	climate-related disasters, and possible mitigations and
12	alternatives.
13	"Department" means the department of health.
14	"Project" means any planned building, transportation, or
15	land use change by any public or private entity that may
16	generate significant greenhouse gas emissions in the
17	construction or operation phase of the project.
18	§ -2 Climate vulnerability assessment. State agencies
19	shall require a climate vulnerability assessment for all permit

applications for projects filed after December 31, 2019.

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- 1 -3 Rules. The department shall adopt rules pursuant
- to chapter 91 to implement this chapter. The rules may include 2
- exemptions for certain projects." 3
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
