A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 91-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definitions of "contested case" and
- 3 "rule" to read as follows:
- 4 ""Contested case" means a proceeding in which the legal
- 5 rights, duties, or privileges of specific parties are required
- 6 by law to be determined after an opportunity for agency hearing.
- 7 The term does not include an agency decision regarding the
- 8 disposition of land by sale, lease, license, permit, or
- 9 otherwise.
- 10 "Rule" means each agency statement of general or particular
- 11 applicability and future effect that implements, interprets, or
- 12 prescribes law or policy, or describes the organization,
- 13 procedure, or practice requirements of any agency. The term
- 14 does not include regulations concerning only the internal
- 15 management of an agency and not affecting private rights of or
- 16 procedures available to the public, nor does the term include
- 17 declaratory rulings issued pursuant to section 91-8, nor intra-

- 1 agency memoranda $[\cdot, \cdot]$, nor does the term include documents or
- 2 agreements realizing the disposition of land by sale, lease,
- 3 license, permit, or otherwise."
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 6 begun before its effective date.
- 7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
