# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1.	The	legislature	finds	that	the	department	of

- 2 agriculture hemp pilot program has been progressing and going
- 3 through the rulemaking development stages. In order to prepare
- 4 the hemp pilot program for implementation, a few amendments must
- 5 be made to address the program's commencement.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to create a special fund into
- 7 which fees may be deposited.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
- 10 designated and to read as follows:
- 11 Industrial hemp special fund; established. (a)
- **12** There is created in the state treasury a special fund to be
- 13 designated as the industrial hemp special fund to be
- 14 administered by the department of agriculture. Moneys deposited
- 15 in this special fund shall be used to fulfill the purposes of
- 16 this part and shall include:
- (1) Any moneys appropriated by the legislature to the 17
- 18 special fund;
