A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
to the department of health for the purchase of ambulance
vehicles and their operational costs, including equipment,
supplies, and personnel costs for state-certified emergency
medical services personnel, for one twenty-four-hour, seven days-a-week ambulance unit for each of the counties of Kauai and
Hawaii.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for 11 two twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week ambulance units, 12 including the purchase of one ambulance vehicle for each unit 13 and operating costs, including equipment, supplies, and 14 personnel costs for state-certified emergency medical services 15 personnel, to be allocated as follows:

16 (1) One unit for the county of Kauai; and

17 (2) One unit for the county of Hawaii.
