RELATING TO EMPLOYEE'S DESIGNATION OF BENEFICIARY FORM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 78-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: Upon discharge, an employee shall be entitled to all 3 4 of the employee's accumulated vacation allowance plus the 5 employee's current accrued vacation allowance to and including the date of discharge, notwithstanding that the current accrued 6 7 vacation allowance may not have been recorded at the time. 8 any employee dies with accumulated or current accrued vacation 9 earned but not taken, an amount equal to the value of the 10 employee's pay over the period of [such] the earned vacation, 11 and any earned and unpaid wages, shall be paid [to]: 12 To the person or persons who may have been designated (1) 13 as the beneficiary or beneficiaries by the employee 14 during the employee's lifetime in a [verified written] statement filed either with the comptroller or other 15 16 disbursing officer who issues warrants or checks to
