## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SHARING OF VITAL STATISTICS RECORDS WITH DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH PROGRAM EMPLOYEES FOR APPROVED RESEARCH PURPOSES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§338- Sharing of vital statistics records with		
5	department of health program employees for approved research		
6	purposes. (a) Notwithstanding section 338-18, the department		
7	may disclose public health statistics records to persons who are		
8	employed by department of health programs, acting within the		
9	scope of their employment, and need a public health statistics		
10	record for research purposes, as approved by the department of		
11	health's institutional review committee. Upon the institutional		
12	review committee's approval, the department may disclose the		
13	following to employees as specified in this section:		
14	(1) Names, addresses, and contact information in the		
15	record for the purpose of contacting persons		
16	identified in the record to request informed consent		

1		to use additional specified information in the record.
2		If informed consent is provided, the additional
3		specified information in the record may be disclosed;
4		and
5	(2)	Information in the record as approved by the
6		institutional review committee without informed
7		consent of persons identified in the record so long as
8		the institutional review committee:
9		(A) Identifies the information in the record that may
10		be shared;
11		(B) Determines that obtaining informed consent is not
12		practicable; and
13		(C) Determines that there is a public health purpose
14		of the research that outweighs the
15		confidentiality interest of persons identified in
16		the record.
17	(b)	For purposes of this chapter, research purposes are
18	those tha	t have been approved by the department's institutional
19	review co	mmittee.
20	(c)	For purposes of this section, the requirements for
21	informed	consent shall be determined by the department's

institutional review committee in its approval of the research

purposes for which the information in the record will be shared.

(d) Information disclosed pursuant to this section may

only be redisclosed with authorization from the institutional

review committee or if it is first de-identified."

SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

## Report Title:

Department of Health; Vital Statistics Records; Internal Disclosure for Approved Research Purposes

## Description:

Authorizes the Department of Health to disclose public health statistics records internally within the Department for approved research purposes and establishes conditions under which those records may be disclosed with and without informed consent. (SD1)

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
