SECTION 1. Section 353-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended as follows:

3 "§353-14 Cash furnished discharged committed person, when. 4 Upon the discharge or parole of any committed person who has undergone a commitment or sentence of more than one year, the 5 6 committed person may be furnished by the Hawaii paroling 7 authority, in its discretion, with funds of not more than \$200, 8 to meet the committed person's immediate needs [-]; provided that 9 legislative appropriations for this specific purpose have been 10 authorized and allocated to the authority. The expenditures 11 made by the Hawaii paroling authority shall be included among 12 the accounts for cost and maintenance of committed persons." 13 SECTION 2.
