A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a need to
- 2 upgrade the methods and procedures of state motor vehicle
- 3 inspections because the current system is inefficient in that
- 4 legislation needs to be passed every time an inspection fee is
- 5 amended. The purpose of this Act is to provide the director of
- 6 transportation greater authority over the motor carrier
- 7 inspection program so that the cost to a vehicle owner for an
- ${f 8}$ inspection, the fees collected from inspection stations, and the
- 9 administration of the program can be changed by amending
- 10 administrative rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised
- 11 Statutes.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 286-209, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- amended by amending subsections (b), (c), and (d) to read as
- 14 follows:
- "(b) The director shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
- 16 for the administration and enforcement of motor carrier vehicle
- 17 safety inspections, including the maximum inspection fee to

- 1 vehicle owners, fees collected from the stations, the issuance
- 2 of certificates of safety inspection, the affixing of motor
- 3 carrier vehicle safety inspection [decals,] stickers, and the
- 4 acceptance of certificates of safety inspection issued in other
- 5 jurisdictions.
- 6 (c) The director shall collect a fee of \$1.50 for each
- 7 motor carrier vehicle safety inspection [decal] sticker issued
- 8 by motor carrier vehicle inspection stations [-], until fees
- 9 established by administrative rules pursuant to subsection (b)
- 10 are adopted, at which time the fees adopted by administrative
- 11 rule shall apply. All moneys [collected] received by the
- 12 department of transportation pursuant to this section shall be
- 13 [paid] deposited into the state highway fund.
- 14 (d) A fee of no more than \$12 shall be charged by a motor
- 15 carrier inspection station for each safety inspection
- 16 performed [-], until such fees established by administrative
- 17 rules pursuant to subsection (b) are adopted, at which time the
- 18 fees adopted by administrative rule shall apply."
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 286-210, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:

- 1 "§286-210 Operation of a motor carrier vehicle without a
- 2 safety inspection [decal.] sticker. Whoever operates, permits
- 3 the operation of, causes to be operated, or parks any motor
- 4 carrier vehicle on a public highway without a current motor
- 5 carrier vehicle safety inspection [decal,] sticker, issued under
- 6 section 286-209, shall be fined \$100 for each day of the
- 7 violation."
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 9 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 10 begun, before its effective date.
- 11 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
