A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD SUSTAINABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) Pursuant to section 226-55, Hawaii Revised 2 Statutes, the department of agriculture, in coordination with 3 the office of planning and the department of land and natural resources, shall prepare and periodically update a functional 4 5 plan for seafood sustainability that expands the State's 6 priority on food by including wild seafood as a viable food 7 source. 8 (b) As part of the functional plan for seafood 9 sustainability, the department of agriculture shall consider the 10 following:
- 11 Establishing objectives, policies, and actions related (1) 12 to seafood sustainability;
- Researching the agricultural and economic impact that 13 (2) 14 wild seafood has on food self-sufficiency in the 15 State, including its influence on non-commercial 16 consumption, such as community sharing and fisher 17 household consumption, and exports;

- (4) Classifying and regulating wild seafood as a food
 commodity in the State; and
- 5 (5) Incorporating the functional plan for seafood
 6 sustainability, in part or in whole, into the state
 7 agricultural functional plan related to increased food
 8 security and food self-sufficiency.
- 9 (c) The governor shall submit the functional plan pursuant 10 to section 226-56, Hawaii Revised Statutes, including any 11 proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty 12 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2020.
- (d) For the purposes of this section, "wild seafood" means naturally-born or hatchery-raised fish and shellfish harvested in the wild through commercial, recreational, or subsistence fishing, but excludes net-pen aquacultural or other farm-raised fish.
- 18 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for
 21 the department of agriculture, in coordination with the office

- 1 of planning and department of land and natural resources, to
- 2 prepare and periodically update a functional plan for seafood
- 3 sustainability.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 7 provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
