A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WEED AND SEED STRATEGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that the weed and seed SECTION 1.
- strategy is a United States Department of Justice initiative 2
- that is administered locally by the United States Attorney's 3
- 4 Office.
- 5 The weed and seed strategy is a collaborative effort among
- federal, state, and county level law enforcement agencies, 6
- 7 social service agencies, private businesses, nonprofit
- 8 organizations, and residents to reclaim, restore, and rebuild
- communities. The four key elements of the weed and seed 9
- 10 strategy are:
- 11 Law enforcement; (1)
- Community policing; 12 (2)
- Prevention, intervention, and treatment programs; and 13 (3)
- 14 (4)Neighborhood restoration.
- 15 The weed and seed strategy uses local law enforcement to
- prevent, control, and reduce violent crime, drug abuse, and gang 16
- activity in targeted neighborhoods by "weeding" out the criminal 17

- 1 element in the community. Community policing involves having
- 2 police officers work closely with community residents to develop
- 3 solutions to violent and drug-related crimes. The next step is
- 4 to "seed" the community with human services that include
- 5 prevention, intervention, treatment, and neighborhood
- 6 revitalization.
- 7 The legislature finds that the weed and seed strategy has
- 8 been successful since its inception in the Kalihi-Palama and
- 9 Chinatown areas of downtown Honolulu as well as Waipahu and
- 10 Ewa/Ewa Beach. The legislature also finds that, since the
- 11 beginning of the program, crime in those areas has been
- 12 significantly reduced.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to
- 14 maintain the weed and seed strategy.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$400,000 or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 as a grant
- 18 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Weed and
- 19 Seed Hawaii to maintain the weed and seed program.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 21 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
