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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

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RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The legislature finds that establishing a  
2 facilities special fund for the state public charter school  
3 commission and charter schools will create a mechanism for  
4 providing and distributing funding for facility costs.

5       SECTION 2. Chapter 302D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
6 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
7 and to read as follows:

8       "§302D-       Charter schools facilities special fund. (a)

9       There is established in the state treasury the charter schools  
10       facilities special fund.

11       (b) The following shall be deposited into the special  
12       fund:

13       (1) Appropriations by the legislature for facilities  
14       funding pursuant to section 302D-29.5; and

15       (2) Grants and donations from the federal government or  
16       any other governmental agency or any private person  
17       for charter schools facility funding.



1        (c) The proceeds of the special fund shall be expended for  
2        the funding of charter school facilities in accordance with  
3        legislative appropriations pursuant to section 302D-29.5.

4        (d) No debt service on any bonds shall be paid from the  
5        special fund.

6        (e) No payment shall be made from the special fund for any  
7        obligation of the commission or a charter school under any  
8        financing agreement entered into pursuant to chapter 37D.

9        (f) The commission shall administer the special fund."

10       SECTION 3. Section 36-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
11       amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

12       "(a) Except as provided in this section, and  
13       notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, from time to  
14       time, the director of finance, for the purpose of defraying the  
15       prorated estimate of central service expenses of government in  
16       relation to all special funds, except the:

17       (1) Special out-of-school time instructional program fund  
18       under section 302A-1310;

20       education;

shall deduct five per cent of all receipts of all other special  
funds, which deduction shall be transferred to the general fund  
of the State and become general realizations of the State. All  
officers of the State and other persons having power to allocate  
or disburse any special funds shall cooperate with the director



1 in effecting these transfers. To determine the proper revenue  
2 base upon which the central service assessment is to be  
3 calculated, the director shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter  
4 91 for the purpose of suspending or limiting the application of  
5 the central service assessment of any fund. No later than  
6 twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session of  
7 the legislature, the director shall report all central service  
8 assessments made during the preceding fiscal year."

9 SECTION 4. Section 36-30, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

11 "(a) Each special fund, except the:

12 (1) Special out-of-school time instructional program fund  
13 under section 302A-1310;

14 (2) School cafeteria special funds of the department of  
15 education;

16 (3) Special funds of the University of Hawaii;

17 (4) State educational facilities improvement special fund;

18 (5) Special funds established by section 206E-6;

1 shall be responsible for its pro rata share of the  
2 administrative expenses incurred by the department responsible  
3 for the operations supported by the special fund concerned."

4 SECTION 5. Section 302D-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
5 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

6 "(c) ~~[In the event of]~~ If a public charter school  
7 ~~[closure]~~ closes for any reason~~[, if]~~ and the public charter  
8 school received an appropriation for capital improvements to its  
9 facilities, the charter school or its authorizer shall negotiate  
10 with the expending agency for a lump sum or installment  
11 repayment to the State of the amounts appropriated. This  
12 restriction shall be registered, recorded, and indexed in the  
13 bureau of conveyances or with the assistant registrar of the  
14 land court as an encumbrance on the property. Amounts received  
15 from the repayment under this subsection shall be deposited into  
16 the general fund~~[.]~~ if the appropriation for the capital  
17 improvements was made from other than the charter schools  
18 facilities special fund. If the appropriation for the capital  
19 improvements was made from the charter schools facilities  
20 special fund, the payment shall be deposited into that special  
21 fund."



SECTION 6. Section 302D-25, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

**"§302D-25 Applicability of state laws.** (a) Charter schools shall be exempt from chapters 91 and 92 and all other state laws in conflict with this chapter, except those regarding:

(1) Collective bargaining under chapter 89; provided that:

(A) The exclusive representatives as defined in chapter 89 and the governing board of the charter school may enter into supplemental agreements that contain cost and noncost items to facilitate decentralized decision-making;

(B) The agreements shall be funded from the current allocation or other sources of revenue received by the charter school; provided that collective bargaining increases for employees shall be allocated by the department of budget and finance to the charter school's authorizer for distribution to the charter school; and

(C) These supplemental agreements may differ from the master contracts negotiated with the department;



1 (2) Discriminatory practices under section 378-2; and

2 (3) Health and safety requirements.

3 (b) Charter schools, the commission, and authorizers shall  
4 be exempt from chapter 103D, but shall develop internal policies  
5 and procedures for the procurement of goods, services, and  
6 construction, consistent with the goals of public accountability  
7 and public procurement practices. Charter schools, the  
8 commission, and authorizers are encouraged to use the provisions  
9 of chapter 103D where possible; provided that the use of one or  
10 more provisions of chapter 103D shall not constitute a waiver of  
11 the exemption from chapter 103D and shall not subject the  
12 charter school, commission, or authorizer to any other provision  
13 of chapter 103D. Charter schools, the commission, and  
14 authorizers shall account for funds expended for the procurement  
15 of goods and services, and this accounting shall be available to  
16 the public.

17 (c) Charter schools and their employees, the commission  
18 and its employees, and governing boards and their members shall  
19 be subject to chapter 84.

20 (d) Any charter school, prior to the beginning of the  
21 school year, may enter into an annual contract with any



1 department for centralized services to be provided by that  
2 department.

3 (e) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, as public  
4 schools and entities of the State, a charter school, including  
5 its governing board, the commission, and any authorizer may not  
6 bring suit against any other entity or agency of the State.

7 (f) Charter schools, the commission, and authorizers shall  
8 be exempt from section 302A-1401.

9 (g) For purposes of statutory delegation of authority to  
10 department heads by other state agencies, the executive director  
11 shall be deemed the department head of the commission and  
12 charter schools unless otherwise specifically provided.

13 (h) The charter schools facilities special fund shall be  
14 exempt from the central service expense assessment of section  
15 36-27 and departmental administrative expense assessment of  
16 section 36-30."

17 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
