A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to assist 11 farmers, ranchers, and other food vendors registered with the 12 Hawaii farm to school program in acquiring good agricultural practices certifications from the United States Department of 13 14 Agriculture. 15 SECTION 6. The sums appropriated by sections 3 through 5 of this Act shall be expended by the department of agriculture 16 17 for the purposes of this Act. 18 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050, and 19 shall be repealed on June 30, 2021.

Agriculture; DOA; Hawaii Farm to School Program; Farm to School Grant Pilot Program; Appropriation

Description:

Establishes and appropriates funds for a Farm to School Grant Pilot Program within the Hawaii Department of Agriculture to provide grants to schools, early care and education centers, nonprofits, soil and water conservation districts, and food producers participating in the Hawaii Farm to School Program. Requires the Hawaii Farm to School Coordinator to submit a report to the Legislature. Makes appropriations to continue the Hawaii Farm to School Program and Coordinator position and to assist farmers and ranchers achieve Good Agricultural Practices Certification from the United States Department of Agriculture. Repeals on 6/30/2021. (SB2928 HD1)

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
