A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KING KAMEHAMEHA CELEBRATION COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	" <u>§8-</u> King Kamehameha celebration commission special
5	fund. (a) There is established a King Kamehameha celebration
6	commission special fund, which shall be administered by the
7	department of accounting and general services, into which shall
8	be deposited the following moneys:
9	(1) Appropriations by the legislature to the special fund;
10	and
11	(2) Gifts, donations, and grants from public agencies and
12	private persons.
13	(b) All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited in
14	the fund shall become part of the fund.
15	(c) Subject to legislative appropriation, the King
16	Kamehameha celebration commission may expend moneys from the

17 King Kamehameha celebration commission special fund solely for



1	the purpose of paying expenses arising out of the annual King	
2	Kamehameha day celebration events.	
3	(d) The department of accounting and general services	
4	shall adopt rules in accordance with chapter 91 for the purposes	
5	of this section."	
6	SECTION 2. Section 8-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
7	amended to read as follows:	
8	"§8-5 King Kamehameha celebration commission. (a) There	
9	shall be a commission to be known as the King Kamehameha	
10	celebration commission placed within the department of	
11	accounting and general services for administrative purposes.	
12	The commission shall consist of [thirteen] fifteen members to be	
13	appointed by the governor in the manner provided by section 26-	
14	34. The appointments shall be made from the following	
15	organizations, with at least one member from each organization:	
16	(1) Royal Order of Kamehameha I;	
17	(2) 'Ahahui Ka'ahumanu;	
18	(3) Hale O Nā Aliʻi O Hawaiʻi ʻAhahui Poʻo;	
19	(4) Daughters and Sons of Hawaiian Warriors $[+]$	
20	Mamakakaua;	
21	(5) Kamehameha Schools Alumni Association;

1 The terms of all appointments shall be four years. (b) 2 The governor shall appoint the chairperson of the commission 3 from among the members. The chairperson may appoint an advisory committee composed of past commission members and personnel to 4 5 advise the chairperson on historical and archival background of 6 the commission. 7 (C)The members of the King Kamehameha celebration commission shall serve without compensation, but shall be 8 9 entitled to reimbursement for travel and necessary expenses 10 while attending meetings and while in discharge of their duties. The comptroller shall reimburse the members of the King 11 12 Kamehameha celebration commission for all necessary expenses incurred during the discharge of their duties. 13 The commission may appoint and dismiss an arts program 14 (d) 15 specialist and a part-time clerk typist, without regard to chapter 76, who shall serve at the commission's pleasure, and 16 whose salaries shall be provided through fees, public 17 contributions, and private donations. The commission, by a 18 19 majority vote, shall appoint an executive director, who shall: 20 (1) Serve without regard to chapter 76 for a term to be 21 determined by the commission;

1	(2)	Serve as the commission's chief executive officer;		
2	(3)	Be responsible for all fiscal and administrative		
3		matters, including securing public contributions, and		
4		private foundation grants and donations, except for		
5		matters assigned to the comptroller pursuant to

7	(4)	Be responsible for developing and administering the		
8		programs under the commission's direction; and		
9	(5)	Be familiar with the people and culture of Hawaii.		
10	The salary of the executive director shall be established by the			
11	commissio	n and shall not exceed the salary of any department		
12	<u>head or e</u>	xecutive officer. The commission, by a two-thirds vote		
13	of all me	mbers to which it is entitled, may remove the executive		
14	director	for cause at any time.		
15	(e)	The commission shall have charge of all arrangements		
16	for the c	elebration under the direction of the commission each		
17	year gene	rally observed throughout Hawai'i Nei on June 11, and		
18	shall sup	port other events as approved by the commission to		
19	commemora	te the memory of the great Polynesian Hawaiian warrior		
20	and state	sman King Kamehameha I, who united the Hawaiian Islands		
21	into the	Kingdom of Hawaiʻi, and is recognized as such under		



section 8-1. The commission may appoint committees and delegate
 powers and duties to the committees as it shall determine.

3 (f) The comptroller shall account for all moneys appropriated by the legislature, may raise funds to defray 4 administrative costs, and may accept donations of money and 5 personal property on behalf of the commission; provided that all 6 7 donations accepted from private sources shall be expended in the manner prescribed by the contributor, and all moneys received 8 9 from all sources shall be deposited into the commission's trust 10 account.

11 The commission shall be the coordinating agency for (q) 12 all [state sponsored as well as other celebration events staged during the celebration period] commission-approved events as set 13 forth in subsection (e) and as designated by the commission to 14 15 [assure] ensure activities planned are timely and appropriate to 16 commemorate the memory of King Kamehameha I. The commission is 17 authorized to determine to whom and for which occasions 18 permission is to be granted for the use of the statue of King 19 Kamehameha I.

20 (h) The commission shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
21 91 necessary for the purpose of this section."

SECTION 3. The members of the King Kamehameha celebration
 commission serving on the day before the effective day of this
 Act shall continue to serve until their term expires, at which
 time, members of the commission shall be appointed in the manner
 set forth in section 2 of this Act.
