A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 302A-1303.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,	
2	is amended to read as follows:		
3	"§30:	2A-1303.5 Committee on weights. (a) There is	
4	establish	ed within the department of education the committee on	
5	weights t	o develop a weighted student formula pursuant to	
6	section 3	02A-1303.6. The committee may:	
7	(1)	Create a list of [student characteristics] factors	
8		that will be weighted[+] including but not limited to	
9		student characteristics, enrollment trends, and	
10		optimal student-teacher ratios;	
11	(2)	Create a system of weights based upon the student	
12		characteristics that may be applied to determine the	
13		relative cost of educating any student;	
14	(3)	Determine the optimal student-teacher ratio for each	
15		grade level from kindergarten through grade twelve;	
16	[-(3) -]	(4) Determine specific student weights, including	
17		their unit value;	

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1	[-(4)-]	(5) Determine which moneys shall be included in the
2		amount of funds to be allocated through the weighted
3		student formula;
4	[(5)]	(6) Recommend a weighted student formula to the board
5		of education;
6	[(6)]	(7) Perform any other function that may facilitate
7		the implementation of the weighted student formula;
8		and
9	[(7)]	(8) Meet not less than once every odd-numbered year,
10		to review the weighted student formula and, if the
11		committee deems it necessary, recommend a new weighted
12		student formula for adoption by the board of
13		education.
14	(b)	When developing the weighted student formula, the
15	committee	shall incorporate into the formula:
16	(1)	Weights to account for necessary special education
17		teachers and special education support staff;
18	(2)	Weights to account for anticipated enrollment
19		increases and associated facility concerns; and
20	(3)	Weights representing the optimal student-teacher ratio
21		at each grade level.

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- 1 $\frac{(c)}{(c)}$ The composition of the committee on weights
- 2 shall be determined by the board of education based on
- 3 recommendations from the superintendent of education and dean of
- 4 the University of Hawaii at Manoa college of education and
- 5 include principals, teachers, and other members with the
- 6 appropriate professional skills, experiences, and qualifications
- 7 needed to facilitate the work of the committee. The
- 8 superintendent or the superintendent's designee shall chair the
- 9 committee on weights.
- 10 [(c)] (d) The committee on weights may form advisory
- 11 subcommittees to obtain input from key stakeholders as
- 12 determined necessary by the committee.
- 13 $\left[\frac{d}{d}\right]$ (e) The members of the committee on weights shall
- 14 serve at the pleasure of the board of education and shall not be
- 15 subject to section 26-34. Members of the committee on weights
- 16 shall serve without compensation but shall be reimbursed for
- 17 expenses, including travel expenses, necessary for the
- 18 performance of their duties."

- 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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Report Title:

Department of Education; Weighted Student Formula

Description:

Allows for several factors to be weighted for the weighted student formula including but not limited to student characteristics, enrollment trends, and optimal student-teacher ratios. Requires the committee on weights to incorporate into the weighted student formula weights that account for special education teachers and support staff, enrollment increases, and the optimal student-teacher ratio at each grade level.

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
