## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING CONGRESS TO CONVENE A LIMITED NATIONAL CONVENTION UNDER ARTICLE V FOR THE EXCLUSIVE PURPOSE OF PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION THAT WILL LIMIT THE INFLUENCE OF MONEY IN OUR ELECTORAL PROCESS.

1 2 3 4 5	WHEREAS, the framers of the Constitution of the United States of America intended that the Congress of the United States of America should be "dependent on the people alone" (James Madison, Federalist 52); and
6	WHEREAS, that dependency has evolved from a dependency on
7	the people alone to a dependency on powerful special interests,
8	through campaigns or third-party groups, that has created a
9	fundamental imbalance in our representative democracy; and
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11	WHEREAS, Americans across the political spectrum agree that
12 13	elections in the United States of America should be free from the disproportional influence of special interests and fair
13 14	enough that any citizen can be elected into office; and
15	chough that any creizen can be creeted into orrice, and
16	WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution
17	requires Congress to call a convention for proposing amendments
18	to the federal Constitution on the application of two-thirds of
19	the legislatures of the several states; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Hawaii states
22 23	that all political power "is inherent in the people and the responsibility for the exercise thereof rests with the people.
23 24	All government is founded on this authority" (Article I, Section
25	1); and

27	WHEREAS, the Hawaii State Legislature perceives the need
28	for an amendments convention in order to restore balance and
29	integrity to our elections by proposing an amendment to the



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1 federal Constitution that will permanently protect free and fair 2 elections in America by addressing, inter alia, issues raised by 3 the decisions of the United States Supreme Court in *Citizens* 4 United v. Federal Election Commission, 130 S.Ct. 876 (2010) and 5 related cases and events, and desires that said convention 6 should be so limited; and 7

8 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii desires that the delegates to 9 said convention shall be comprised equally of individuals currently elected to State and local office, or be selected by 10 election, in each Congressional district for the purpose of 11 12 serving as delegates, provided that all individuals elected or 13 appointed to federal office, now or in the past, be prohibited from serving as delegates to the convention, as the State 14 15 intends to retain the ability to restrict or expand the power of its delegates within the limits expressed herein; and 16

WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii intends that this be a 18 19 continuing application considered together with applications 20 calling for a convention passed in the 2013-2014 Vermont Legislature as R-454, the 2013-2014 California Legislature as 21 Concurrent Resolution Chapter 77, the 98th Illinois General 22 Assembly as SJR 42, the 2014-2015 New Jersey Legislature as SCR 23 132, the 2015-2016 Rhode Island Legislature as HR 7670 and SR 24 2589, and all other passed, pending, and future applications 25 until such time as two-thirds of the several states have applied 26 for a convention for a similar purpose and said convention is 27 28 convened by Congress; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth 30 31 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the House of Representatives concurring, that this body hereby 32 33 requests the United States Congress to call a convention for the exclusive purpose of proposing an amendment to the Constitution 34 of the United States of America that will limit the influence of 35 money in our electoral process, by overturning the decision of 36 the United States Supreme Court in Citizens United v. Federal 37 38 Elections Commission and related cases, as soon as two-thirds of 39 the several states have applied for a convention for a similar 40 purpose; and



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this application is for an Article V convention and does not grant Congress the authority to call a convention for any purpose other than for the sole purpose set forth in this resolution, as soon as two-thirds of the several states have applied for a convention for a similar purpose; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 8 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 9 United States, the Vice President of the United States in his 10 capacity as presiding officer of the United States Senate, the 11 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the 12 13 Minority Leader of the United States House of Representatives, 14 the President Pro Tempore of the United States Senate, to each Senator and Representative from Hawaii in the Congress of the 15 United States with the respectful request that the full and 16 17 complete text of this Concurrent Resolution be printed in the Congressional Record, and to the presiding officers of each 18 legislative body of each of the several states, requesting the 19 20 cooperation of the states in issuing an application compelling Congress to call a convention for proposing amendments pursuant 21 22 to Article V of the U.S. Constitution.
