H.B. No. 1082 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO GOVERNMENTAL RETENTION OF
ATTORNEYS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to increase the efficiency,
effectiveness, and capacity of the Division of Financial
Institutions (DFI) of the Department of Commerce and Consumer
Affairs by allowing the DFI to hire or retain attorneys for other
purposes rather than solely for actions involving the Mortgage
Loan Recovery Fund.

The Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs supported
this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its
effective date to July 1, 2099, to promote further discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Intrastate Commerce that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
No. 1082, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1082, H.D. 1, and
be referred to your Committee on Labor & Public Employment.
