Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1310, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE WAIAKEA PENINSULA REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to revitalize and redevelop the Waiakea Peninsula on Hawaii Island and stimulate the economy of East Hawaii by establishing the Waiakea Peninsula Redevelopment District, Planning Committee, and Revolving Fund.

The Councilmember representing District 3 of the Hawaii County Council, Banyan Drive Hawaii Redevelopment Agency, Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO, International Longshore and Warehouse Union Local 142, Kanoelehua Industrial Area Association, Pacific Resource Partnership, Hawaii Planing Mill, Ltd. dba HPM Building Supply, Kadota Liquor, Kamehameha Schools, Hawaii Laborers-Employers Cooperation and Education Trust, and three individuals supported this measure.
