"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO COLLECTION OF RESTITUTION FOR CRIME VICTIMS,"

The purpose of this measure is to facilitate the payment of restitution to victims of crime by:

- (1) Establishing standards and procedures for income withholding from the defendant; and
- (2) Appropriating funds to the Department of the Attorney General for enhancing restitution collection.

The Crime Victim Compensation Commission, City and County of Honolulu Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, Oahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawaii, and an individual testified in support of this measure.
