"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT,"

The purpose of this measure is to prohibit state law enforcement agencies from complying with federal immigration detainers or honoring requests for non-public information about individuals unless specifically required to do so by a warrant signed by a judge or provisions of federal, state, or local law.

Planned Parenthood Votes Northwest and Hawaii, American Civil Liberties Union People Power, Hawaii J-20+, The Libertarian Party of Hawaii, Filipina Advocacy Network, Hawaii Coalition for Immigration Reform, IMUAlliance, Ho'omanapono Political Action Committee, and numerous concerned individuals supported this measure. The County of Maui Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, Maui Police Department, and a few concerned individuals opposed this measure. The Department of the Attorney General and American Civil Liberties Union of Hawaii offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

 Changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to promote further discussion; and
