"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO VICTIMS OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE," begs leave to report as follows:


The purpose of this measure is to require that accident and health or sickness insurance policies include coverage for appropriate clinical victim support services provided by licensed mental health providers for victims of sexual violence and abuse who suffer from mental disorders. This measure also defines "clinical victim support service" and "victim of sexual violence or abuse" for the purposes of insurance coverage.

The Sex Abuse Treatment Center of Kapi'olani Medical Center for Women & Children, IMUAlliance, Hawaii Children's Action Network, Kaiser Permanente Hawaii, Domestic Violence Action Center, Hawai'i Democratic Women's Caucus, and a few concerned individuals supported this measure. The Department of Human Services, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Hawaii Medical Service Association, and Planned Parenthood Votes Northwest and Hawaii provided comments.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your

Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 2128, H.D. 2, and recommends that it pass Third Reading.
