The purpose of this measure is to allow the Department of
Agriculture to maintain consistent funding to meet its statutory
mandate under the State's pesticide program, including
registration and licensing, certification and education, and
compliance monitoring, and to provide pesticide regulation with
informed and educated studies by increasing the cap on the
Pesticide Use Revolving Fund from \$250,000 to \$1,000,000.


The Department of Agriculture, Hawaii Crop Improvement
