Your Committee on Labor & Public Employment, to which was referred H.B. No. 2383 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SPECIAL DUTY FOR DEPUTY SHERIFFS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish statutory authorization for special duty employment, commonly referred to as special duty services, by deputy sheriffs.

The Department of Public Safety; Department of Taxation; University of Hawaii; Office of Elections; Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO; and an individual testified in support of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to January 1, 2050, to facilitate further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Labor & Public Employment that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of



H.B. No. 2383, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass
