Your Committee on Housing, to which was referred H.B. No. 396
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING
AUTHORITY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize Hawaii Public
Housing Authority (HPHA) to evict a tenant if the tenant is
convicted of a misdemeanor or felony related to HPHA's property or
funds during the term of tenancy.

HPHA and numerous individuals testified in support of this
measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its
effective date to take effect upon a date to be determined, to
facilitate further discussion on this measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Housing that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
396, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading
in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 396, H.D. 1, and be
referred to your Committee on Judiciary.
