Sir:

Your Committee on Housing, to which was referred H.B. No. 829  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require Hawaii Public  
Housing Authority (HPHA) to document smoking violations and retain  
all violations on a resident's record permanently.

One individual testified in support of this measure. HPHA,  
Coalition for a Tobacco-Free Hawaii, and an individual commented  
on this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Requiring HPHA to document each violation observed by  
authority staff, agents, or authorized representatives  
and retain residents' records of violations for up to  
three years; and
- (2) Changing its effective date to take effect upon a date  
to be determined to facilitate further discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Housing that is attached to this report, your  
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.  
829, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading
