Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred H.B. No. 946 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HIGH OCCUPANCY VEHICLE LANES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to specify that an unauthorized person who drives in a high occupancy vehicle lane shall be deemed to have committed a traffic infraction and is subject to a \$150 fine.

The Department of Transportation and an individual supported this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Judiciary that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
