Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 967 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to advance student mental
health treatment at the University of Hawaii at Manoa by
establishing and funding:

- (1) Three full-time psychologist positions; and
- (2) One full-time case manager position.

The Councilmember representing Council District 8 of the City
and County of Honolulu, University of Hawaii at Manoa, Counseling
and Student Development Center at the University of Hawaii at
Manoa, Associated Students of the University of Hawaii Committee
on External Affairs, University of Hawaii Student Caucus, Graduate
Student Organization at the University of Hawaii at Manoa, Hawaii
Psychological Association, and numerous individuals testified in
support of this measure.


Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its
effective date to July 1, 2050.
