SEEK GREATER FEDERAL FUNDING FOR CONSTRUCTING BIKE AND
PEDESTRIAN PATHS AND IMPROVING CURRENTLY AVAILABLE BIKE AND

and recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Finance.
