Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred H.R. No. 110 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE USAGE OF HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE WHEN REFERRING TO THE NAMES OF PLACES AND GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURES IN HAWAI'I,"
