Your Committee on Health & Human Services, to which was referred H.R. No. 13 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, AND JUDICIARY TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH AND PARTICIPATE IN THE HAWAII INTERAGENCY STATE YOUTH NETWORK OF CARE TO BETTER SERVE YOUTH AND FAMILIES WITH COMPLEX NEEDS IN THE STATE,"

The purpose of this measure is to urge the Department of Education, Department of Health, Department of Human Services, and Judiciary to permanently establish and participate in the Hawaii Interagency State Youth Network of Care to better serve youth and families with complex needs in the state.

Your Committee notes that the Department of Human Services testified that no additional appropriation is necessary to fulfill this measure's request.


