Your Committee on Water & Land, to which was referred H.R. No. 155 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO USE THE WAI'ANAE SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES PLAN WHEN APPROVING PLANNING PERMITS ISSUED FOR DEVELOPMENTS ON THE WAI'ANAE COAST,"
