The purpose of this measure is to address Hawaii's high cost
of living by urging the President of the United States and United
States Congress to increase funding dedicated to Hawaii through
the Department of Housing and Urban Development to:

- (1) Support housing initiatives that provide relief to
Hawaii's residents, who pay one of the highest housing
costs in the nation; and
- (2) Mitigate any adverse effects of the Tax Cuts and Jobs
Act of 2017 on Hawaii's residents.

The Hawaii Public Housing Authority, Oahu County Committee on
Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, and Land
Use Research Foundation of Hawaii supported this measure.
