Your Committee on Housing, to which was referred H.R. No. 4
entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO
REDUCE WAIT TIMES FOR HOUSING CONSTRUCTION PERMITS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to urge the City and County of
Honolulu to review its permit requirements, processes, and zoning
laws to reduce the wait times for building permits to less than
six months and to reevaluate and shorten the time for receipt of
permits for accessory and ohana dwelling units intended for
residential rental.

The Honolulu County Republican Party and an individual
supported this measure. The Department of Planning and Permitting
for the City and County of Honolulu offered comments for this
measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Housing that is attached to this report, your
