Your Committee on Veterans, Military, & International
Affairs, & Culture and the Arts, to which was referred S.B. No.
2204, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF
THE HAWAII STATE CAPITOL,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to encourage public
understanding of the history and purpose of the Hawaii State
Capitol, the historic building, and its role in Hawaii's history,
and promote appreciation for the heritage and character of Hawaii
by appropriating moneys to the State Foundation on Culture and the
Arts to fund celebrations for the fiftieth anniversary of the
Hawaii State Capitol.

The State Foundation on Culture and the Arts, Historic Hawai'i
Foundation, and Oahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of
the Democratic Party of Hawai'i testified in support of this
measure. The Center for Hawaiian Sovereignty Studies testified in
support of the intent of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting language requiring the State Foundation on Culture and the Arts to use a portion of the funds appropriated for the establishment of a kiosk or shop on the grounds of the Hawaii State Capitol to disseminate information and other materials and items, for free and for sale, regarding the Hawaii State Capitol and its history to visitors to the State Capitol, including tourists;
- (2) Changing its effective date to June 15, 2015, to facilitate further discussion; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Veterans, Military, & International Affairs, & Culture and the Arts that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2204, S.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2204, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Finance.
