Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred S.B. No. 2346, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Establish an address confidentiality program within the Department of the Attorney General to help survivors of domestic abuse, sexual offenses, or stalking relocate and keep their actual address confidential; and
- (2) Appropriate funds to the Department of the Attorney General for the implementation and operation of the address confidentiality program.

The American Association of University Women of Hawaii, Domestic Violence Action Center, Hawai'i State Democratic Women's Caucus, Hawaii Women Lawyers, Parents And Children Together, Oahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawai'i, and two individuals testified in support of this measure.
