"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS,"

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to the Department of Education to contract with licensed behavior analysts to provide behavior analysis services to public school students.

Hawaii State Teachers Association, Hawaii Disability Rights Center, IMUAlliance, Oahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawaii, Hawai'i Association for Behavior Analysis, Aloha Behavioral Associates, and several concerned individuals supported this measure.
