Your Committee on Housing, to which was referred S.B.
No. 2784 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING
AUTHORITY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to create an
eviction process for the Hawaii Public Housing Authority's state
low-income housing projects and elder or elderly housing.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Hawaii Public Housing Authority and League of Women
Voters of Hawaii.


Your Committee finds that Act 114, Session Laws of Hawaii
2017 (Act 114), exempted state low-income housing directly
controlled, owned, or managed by the Hawaii Public Housing
Authority from the requirements of the residential landlord-tenant
code under chapter 521, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Act 114 was the
first step in creating a uniform eviction process for state and
federal low-income public housing to ensure all tenants receive
the same due process rights regardless of the property on which
they reside. This measure streamlines the eviction process for
all of the Hawaii Public Housing Authority's state and federal
low-income public housing programs and lessens the caseload of the
Judiciary and the Department of the Attorney General.



Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency, including changing the new part added to chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to a subpart in part III of chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to state low-income housing.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Housing that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2784, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2784, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Judiciary.


